OLD BUSINESS:

Norma Yarborough made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 2018 meeting. Robert Fuqua seconded. The motion passed.

The board has decided to meet at 6 pm instead of 6:30 pm. This is a permanent change.

Dana Tiblier gave a report on bank balances, reserve funds, delinquent accounts, and maintenance on site.

NEW BUSINESS:

Darryl Brady made a motion to approve the bid of Mack Enterprises to replace the carport roof of unit 601. Norma Yarborough seconded. The motion passed.

Darryl Brady made a motion to amend the pool rules. Food and alcohol are banned from the pool area and a \$300 dollar fine will be assessed to any unit whose owners or guests bring glass into the pool area. Robert Fuqua seconded. The motion passed.

Darryl Brady made a motion to change the lock on pool enclosure in September. The lock is becoming worn. Norma Yarborough seconded. The motion passed. New keys will be distributed to eligible homeowners during the winter of 2019.

The Board reviewed more than 10 requests from homeowners on a variety of topics. Dana Tiblier will respond by mail to the unit owners regarding the board's decisions.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m. The next meeting of the board will be on Tuesday, July 3rd, 2018, at 6:00 pm. This will be an executive meeting.
